Retail Trading Hours Act 1987

### Retail Trading Hours (Tourism Precincts) Order 2009

Made by the Minister for Commerce under section 12A of the Act.

**1. Citation**

This order is the *Retail Trading Hours (Tourism Precincts) Order 2009*.

**2. Commencement**

This order comes into operation as follows —

- (a) clauses 1 and 2 — on the day on which this order is published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the order — on 1 January 2010.

**3. Retail trading hours — Fremantle tourism precinct**

- (1) On the days specified in column 1 of the Table, general retail shops in the Fremantle tourism precinct are required to be closed during the hours specified opposite those days in column 2.

- (2) Despite subclause (1), general retail shops in the Fremantle tourism precinct are required to be closed until 8 a.m. and from and after 5 p.m. on any day that is appointed or declared a public holiday for that precinct or throughout the State by or under the *Public and Bank Holidays Act 1972*, other than —
- (a) ANZAC Day;
  - (b) Good Friday; and
  - (c) Christmas Day,

on which days the shops will remain closed all day.

**4. Retail trading hours — Perth tourism precinct**

- (1) On the days specified in column 1 of the Table, general retail shops in the Perth tourism precinct are required to be closed during the hours specified opposite those days in column 2.

- (2) Despite subclause (1), general retail shops in the Perth tourism precinct are required to be closed until 8 a.m. and from and after 5 p.m. on any day that is appointed or declared a public holiday for that precinct or throughout the State by or under the *Public and Bank Holidays Act 1972*, other than —
- (a) ANZAC Day;
  - (b) Good Friday; and
  - (c) Christmas Day,

on which days the shops will remain closed all day.

**5. Revocation**

The *Retail Trading Hours (Tourism Precincts) Order 2008* is revoked.

**Retail Trading Hours (Tourism Precincts and Holiday Resorts) Amendment Regulations 2010**

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

**1. Citation**

These regulations are the *Retail Trading Hours (Tourism Precincts and Holiday Resorts) Amendment Regulations 2010*.

**2. Commencement**

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 — on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations — on the day after that day.

**3. Regulations amended**

These regulations amend the *Retail Trading Hours (Tourism Precincts and Holiday Resorts) Regulations 2007*.

**4. Regulation 3 amended**

In regulation 3 delete “falling within”.

**5. Regulation 4 amended**

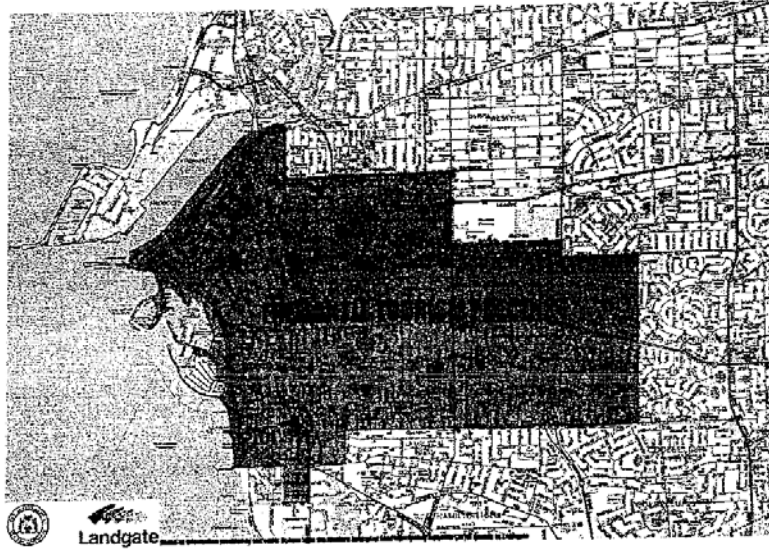
In regulation 4 delete “falling within”.

**Division 1 — Fremantle tourism precinct**

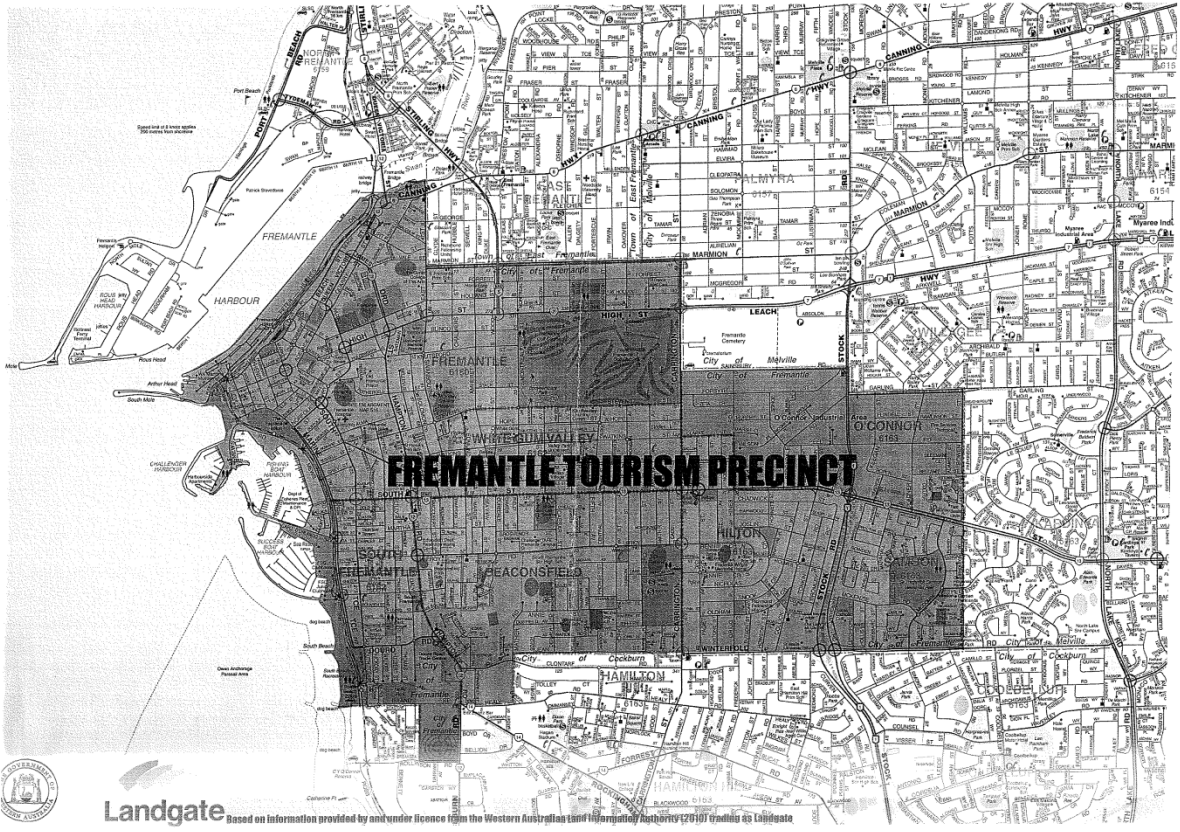
